

BIO: CHUCK BOGGS

Charles "Chuck" Boggs is the CEO & President of ACE, LLC SOLAR; a Pulaski, TN-based, general construction & solar energy system installation company. Currently involved in the development of the enerG•Station; a cutting-edge solar technology solution. With over 44 years of experience in the construction industry servicing the private sector, government and military. Project locations include 30 of the United States, Guam, Palau, Chuuk, Saipan, Vietnam, Mexico, and Rota - Spain.

Projects have included fabrication and erection of over 1.5 million tons of red iron; built over 1.1 M sq. ft. of new construction; and building the fire ring for the 1st Space Shuttle launch pad at Cape Kennedy. He was a member of the management team that constructed the 87,200 kW two-stroke, 102-RPM power plant in Guam. Mr. Boggs designed, financed, built and sold a sub-division of single-family homes in Guam. He also fabricated and installed the exhaust system on all the Delorean cars that came into the United States. He also designed and built the communication system for the Daewoo Company on the island of Palau. He has also designed welding equipment for maintenance on rock crushing plants.

Mr. Boggs was awarded the Navy Achievement Medal while serving in the Seabees, along with other distinguished metals and awards. He is a member of SAME (Society of America Military Engineers) and is currently the President of the Boys and Girls Club in Pulaski, TN and the Co-Cub Master for Boys Scouts Pack #1812. He has served on the arbitration team for the Governor of Chuuk and has been a construction consultant to a number of projects since returning to the United States. Mr. Boggs has excellent management and interpersonal skills, managing over 153 construction field crews at the same time.
